


paperwork to qualify for the election.

Candidates may pull papers to run for the office of City Councilmember in the November 8, 2022, election during the nomination period. The nomination period for this election opens on Monday, July 18 and continues through Friday, August 12. The election code states that if an incumbent fails to return Candidate nomination papers by the original deadline, the nomination period will be extended to Wednesday, August 17, 2022. As Councilmember Sarah Gurney has indicated that she will not seek re-election, the Nomination Period is likely to be extended. The City Clerk acting as the City's Elections Official, will issue and receive all related nomination papers. ALL nomination documents must be submitted to the City Clerk's Office at one time and by appointment. The deadline for filing nomination documents is Friday, August 12, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. unless extended as described above.

It is required that due to the length of appointments that an interested person call the Office of the City Clerk at **707-823-1153** or email majority@cityofsebastopol.org to make an appointment.

CLIMATE ACTION FRAMEWORK ADOPTED

On July 19th, 2022, the Sebastopol City Council adopted a Climate Action Framework, a document that will guide the City as it works to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and prepare for climate impacts such as drought and wildfires. The Framework provides an overview of Sebastopol's climate progress so

far and sets goals for additional action.

POLYSTYRENE BAN AND DISPOSABLE FOOD SERVICE WARE BAN IN EFFECT

In May 2019, the Sebastopol City Council enacted a ban on polystyrene and disposable food service ware as part of its **Resolution 6214** to achieve Zero Waste by 2030. During the height of the COVID-19 pandemic, the ban was informally waived. As of August 1, 2022, the ban is fully in effect. In short, under **Sebastopol Municipal Code SMC/8.36.010** polystyrene (commonly referred to as "styrofoam") food service ware and sales are prohibited. All



food service takeout containers must be recyclable or compostable, all food providers shall only provide lids, cutlery, to-go condiment packages and paper straws upon request of customers, and plastic straws are prohibited. The requirement applies to all vendors providing disposable food service ware including restaurants, grocers and other retailers, and special events. 
Music Ensemble played during the celebration.

WATER & SEWER UPDATES

NEW WATER & SEWER RATES AS OF JULY 1, 2022

New water and sewer rates are in effect as of July, 1, 2022. You can see the current rate schedule <u>HERE</u>. Winter averages will be updated on your next bill, with new winter averages based on last winter's lowest average.

PAY YOUR WATER & SEWER BILL ONLINE

Sebastopol offers online billpay for water and sewer service. What are the benefits of online billpay? It's secure, convenient, and green! With an online account, you can set up

paperless billing, have your statement emailed to you, see a full detailed statement of your bill vs. what is provided in the paper form, see your statement immediately as soon as we post billing instead of waiting for a copy of the statement in the mail, and you can set up autopay or just make payments via credit or debit card with the weblink as well.

CITY OF SEBASTOPOL FACADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

The City of Sebastopol offers a program aimed at encouraging local businesses and property owners to improve commercial and industrial buildings. Upgrades, maintenance, and aesthetic enhancements will benefit the entire community and enhance the local economy.

With these objectives in mind, subject to funding availability, the Sebastopol Façade Improvement Program will provide a rebate for expenses incurred on new exterior property improvements made to commercial or industrial buildings within the City of Sebastopol.



To apply for the program a building owner or tenant, with the owner's approval, should fill out the attached application and include bid estimates for the proposed improvement(s). The Planning Department then reviews the submitted application for completeness and batches them to be reviewed on a quarterly basis by the Design Review Board for approval. Deadlines for applications for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 are:

- August 15, 2022
- October 10, 2022
- January 9, 2023
- March 13, 2023



LIBRARY SUMMER READING CHALLENGE DELIVERS FUN, LEARNING AND PRIZES JUNE 6 - AUGUST 13



Join the Sonoma County Library's <u>Summer Reading Challenge</u> for exploration, learning and fun. The Summer Reading Challenge runs from June 6 to August 13 and participants of all ages are challenged to read 20 minutes each day. The library's summer reading offerings include the reading challenge, a <u>community scavenger hunt</u> and virtual and inperson <u>events</u>.

Sign up for the challenge and track your reading online at <u>sonomalibrary.beanstack.org</u>, with the Beanstack Tracker app or by <u>visiting your local library branch</u> for paper logs.

"Sonoma County Library's Summer Reading Challenge celebrates learning—your way. Read something that sparks your curiosity for at least 20 minutes a day. Reading together is a great way to connect with family and friends," said Aleta Dimas, Adult Services Administrator at the Sonoma County Library. "Join us by reading wherever, however and whatever you enjoy, to foster a lifetime of learning!"

Children who don't read during the summer can lose up to two months of learning by the time they return to school in the fall, a concept known as the "summer slide." Reading programs work to prevent this loss of information.

eBooks, audiobooks, eAudiobooks, physical books, graphic novels and even books read out loud by a loved one, all reading counts. Record your minutes regularly to be eligible for weekly raffle prizes. Plus, earn free books when you read for eight hours and again at 16 hours. Reading time must be recorded via Beanstack—or turned in by paper log—by August 13 to be eligible for the grand prize raffle.
