# SEBASTOPOL PUBLIC WORKS CLEANS UP DOWNED TREE FROM LIBBY PARK

On March 14th, during the latest atmospheric river, a large pine tree in Libby Park fell across and blocked Pleasant Hill Avenue. Sebastopol Public Works

personnel worked through the afternoon clearing the tree.

According to Austin Murphy of the Press Democrat, "Sebastopol police closed Pleasant Hill Avenue, from Washington to Valentine Avenue, for about 90 minutes, said Sgt. Charles Wong. The violent uprooting of the tree appeared to have damaged an underground water main pipe, Wong said, which sent water gushing down the street. No one was injured by the falling tree, he said."

After subsequent inspection by the city arborist it was determined that two additional large pine trees were compromised when the original tree fell. In the interest of public safety and recommendation by the arborist that the compromised trees be removed as soon as possible, removal is scheduled for today, March 17. The public is advised to avoid the area where the work is being done.

The AMI Opt-Out Program is for residential customers who prefer not to have the data collector/transmitter installed with their water meter. The program allows customers to have their meter read manually at the end of every month at no additional cost to the customer.

Most customers look forward to having an automated meter installed at their home and taking advantage of the many benefits that this technology offers, such as fewer visits from field service representatives and immediate access to consumption information. 

### **CHANGES TO COVID-19 GUIDANCE**

California Department of Public Health is reviewing COVID-19 guidance so you can best protect yourself, your loved ones and your community. Here are some of the orders and recommendations that have recently changed or will soon:

 Beginning this week, if you test positive for COVID-19, you may end isolation after five days if you feel well, have improving symptoms and are fever-free for 24 hours. There is now less emphasis on testing negative. Additionally, if you end isolation after day five, it is strongly recommended that you wear a mask through day 10 UNLESS you have two sequential negative tests one day apart.



- Beginning April 3, California will no longer require masking in indoor high-risk and health care settings. This includes health care, long-term care, and correctional facilities as well as homeless, emergency, and warming and cooling centers.
   Facilities can now develop and implement their own masking plans based on their needs and local conditions.
- Also beginning April 3, because federal rules ensure that most health care workers remain vaccinated for COVID-19, the state will no longer require vaccination for health care workers including those in adult care, direct care, correctional facilities and detention centers.

### CITY OF SEBASTOPOL HOUSING ELEMENT CERTIFIED



All cities in the State of California are required to maintain a General Plan and Housing Element, which is one of the required chapters of the General Plan and plans for housing within the City of Sebastopol from 2023-2031. The "Sixth Cycle" Housing Element was adopted by the City Council on January 3, 2023, and has been certified.

When the Department of Housing and

Community Development issues a letter finding the Housing Element is in compliance, it is referred to as "certification" of the Housing Element.

Housing Element certification is important for several reasons including local control, Regional Housing Needs Assessment (RHNA) carryover, and eligibility for grant funds. In addition, the certified housing element protects the city from the 'builder's remedy.'

"The builder's remedy allows property owners to bypass most local planning and zoning rules if that city or county has failed to complete certification of a state-mandated eight-year housing plan known as a 'housing element'." 1
