PUBLIC NOTICE: SO. MAIN STREET TREE REPLACEMENT

The removal and replacement of four trees on the 100 block of South Main Street is scheduled to start the week of September 26th with an anticipated completion date of October 3rd. These trees will be replaced with the new Main Street Crape Myrtle variety to complete this section of Main Street. The timing of this work is being scheduled as close to the Fall season as possible in an attempt to minimize disruption



of the Downtown core during the holiday season.

Wear clothes and shoes that can get dirty. Please bring your own water bottle. Gloves, buckets and trash bags will also be provided. *This event is suitable for all ages*. Minors must be accompanied by an adult. We will provide snacks and refreshments.

Laguna Foundation staff and guides will also provide a dynamic and engaging educational component to the workday that will help volunteers learn more about the Laguna de Santa Rosa watershed, including the impacts of invasive species, the importance of native plants, and the natural and cultural history of the area. City of Sebastopol staff will be on hand to help us haul out all of the trash and recyclables.

PREPARE YOUR FAMILY


