

## **North Bay Home Electrification Incentives**

There are multiple incentives to electrify your home. The Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) incentives will most likely be available towards the end of 2023. The State of California will determine how the funds are dispersed and if it is retroactive to the start of 2023. The IRA incentives listed below are based on married Sonoma County homeowners filing jointly with a max income of \$142,000. Lower income people get higher IRA incentives, and upper income people are only eligible for the tax credits. Use the IRA Calculator link below to determine how much your incentives would be.

## Loans

**Sonoma Clean Power** offers zero interest financing for a 10 year period up to \$10,000. Covers ancillary project costs including panel upgrades.

**GoGreen Financing** offers loans from 2.98% to 8.99% interest for terms up to 15 years for loans up to \$50,000.

**Sonoma County's Energy & Sustainability Division** offers PACE financing through the property tax system at 6.99% interest for a term of 10 or 20 years. They also offer help finding a contractor, evaluating solar bids, understanding building audits and assistance in prioritizing your improvements.
