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The submittal information shall be provided to the Planning Department. All submittal information shall be presented along with the Planning Application form, related fees, and any additional information required by the Planning Department before the application can be accepted as complete.

Upon receipt of this information the Planning Department has 30 days in which to determine if the application is complete. Once the application has been deemed complete, the project can be scheduled before the Tree Board. The Tree Board meets on the 1st and 3^{id} Wednesday of each month at Sebastopol City Hall, 7120 Bodega Avenue, Sebastopol, at 4:00 p.m.

The applicant and/or his representative must be present for any meetings. Failure to do so may result in the application being continued.

Size Limit: Plans should not be larger than 30" x 42" trimmed. All plans shall be folded into a 9" x 11" size. Unfolded plans will not be accepted.

<u>Scale</u>: The scale used on submittal plans shall generally be at a $1/8^{\circ} = 10^{\circ}$ for the architectural plans, $1^{\circ} = 20^{\circ}$ for site engineering plans. Include a north arrow, the scale and a bar scale on all plans.

ARBORIST'S REPORT

876 Gravenstein Highway South - Sebastopol Victorian Square November 28, 2017


I visited this site on November 16th at the request of the Planning Dept, who had received an email from a concerned citizen. There is a mature, 8-trunked locust trees growing on the south property line which is heavily infested with mistletoe. The tree is rapidly declining with weak attachments between the trunks, and decay in the base of several of the trunks. There are many targets within striking distance of this tree – parked cars, the office building, homes and pedestrians. As the mistletoe further invades the tree it will become more brittle and prone to trunk failure, and as the decay progresses at the base, those stems will be increasingly weakly-attached. This tree should be removed soon.



ARBORIST'S REPORT

876 Gravenstein Highway South - Sebastopol

June 24, 2018

I visited this site on November 16th, 2017 in response to concerns from a resident to assess the status of a mature, muti-trunk locust tree (*Robinia sp.*). It is growing on the south property line and is heavily invested with mistletoe. This parasite weakens trees structurally as well as conditionally. The tree was decling last fall, and the attachments between the stems are weak, predisposing it to trunk failures. There are many targets if trunks fall here – cars, pedestrians, buildings. It should be removed soon and replaced with a more appropriate species.
